- In many countries, disability is often explained as witchcraft, karma, or bad luck which leads to mistreatment and neglect.
- Globally, disability hinders access to education more than socioeconomic status, rural location, or gender.
- For every child killed in conflict worldwide, 3 are permanently disabled.
